## **Ozaukee County 4-H Foundation Scholarship Application**

The Ozaukee County 4-H Foundation offers scholarships to active 4-H members who are high school seniors or within one-year post-graduation. Applicants must have at least 5 years of 4-H membership and met the annual achievement requirements. In addition, you may not have been a recipient of this scholarship previously.

### **Application Requirements**

Submit the following by February 1<sup>st</sup> (postmarked) to the Scholarship Committee (address below):

1. A cover letter
2. Resume (use form template on pages 3-6) summarizing 4-H achievements, school, church, community involvement, and volunteer activities.
3. An essay response (page 7).
4. One sealed, unopened, General Leader Scholarship Reflection Form (page 8) completed by your 4-H general leader.
5. One sealed, unopened, letter of recommendation from a teacher, advisor, guidance counselor, principal, community leader, clergy, or employer. (not your general leader)
6. An unofficial transcript (high school or college/tech school).

### **Interview Requirement**

All applicants must participate in an interview, which will be scheduled in early March. Please dress appropriately and prepare a 5-minute talk about your 4-H and community involvement. Additional questions will follow your presentation.

### **Scholarship Details and Rules**

1. The scholarship is for any accredited technical, vocational or university school, requiring full-time enrollment of at least 12 credits.
2. Scholarship funds will be disbursed upon successful completion of 12 credit during the first semester, pending submission of your transcripts to [ozco4hfoundation@gmail.com](mailto:ozco4hfoundation@gmail.com).
3. Scholarship recipients must attend the award ceremony at the Ozaukee County Fair or send a representative.
4. If no suitable candidate is selected, the scholarship may be withheld.

### **Selection Criteria**

- 4-H participation and accomplishments: 60%
- School, church, and community involvement: 10%
- Essay: 10%
- Personal interview: 20%
